- The Initial Implementation of The Cross-Border Transport Agreement (IICBTA)



- O GMS CBTA Annex 4: Facilitation of Frontier Crossing Formalities
 - Article 5: Single-Stop Customs Inspection
 - Single-Stop Customs Inspection consists of subjecting the transport operation to customs inspection only once for the purpose of crossing the border between the adjacent countries
- Thailand and Lao PDR signed an MoU on the IICBTA on July 4, 2005
- Lao PDR and Vietnam start SSI and SWI at cross border
 Dansawan Lao Bao on February 6, 2015






Resolution

- O The both countries agree to start SWI/SSI at CCA
- O First step commercial vehicle including people
- O Next step private car, bus, passenger/tourist
- Make addendum (revised MoU IICBTA) and technical arrangement (Customs, Immigration, Quarantine – Health, Animal and Plant)
- At first to use normal formality for each country until all both side agree with common formality
- O Initial implement start on June 2016



Full Implementation of Single Window Inspection(SWI) and Single Stop Inspection(SSI): Joint Customs and Quarantine Inspection in Common Control Area (CCA) and Clearance/Processing of Customs, Quarantine, and Immigration Documents at Country of Entry



C-Customs; Q-Quarantine; I-Immigration; L-Lao PDR; T-Thailand



Goals

- O Shorten the time of customs clearance of goods
- O Reduce transportation costs
